東京之旅

充實學生內在涵養,開拓國際視野及學習自我 成長是我們東山高中王校長及老師們一致的目標。 所以本校除了充實各項軟硬體設備、積極提昇教學 品質外也辦理各項活動,尤其是爲了增廣學生的國 際視野,更辦理與世界各國交流的活動,期盼透過 學校交流及體驗不同文化的方式,培養學生的國際 觀並經由交流過程將台灣行銷至國際以增進各國對 台灣的了解,此次赴日參訪即爲此項活動之一。

此行參訪了東京二所學校,都有其值得我們學 習的特點。東京都立晴海綜合高等學校,他是東京 大學法律系的附設高中,上下課沒有鐘聲,下課也 無任何廣播等制度,只以課表和行事曆引導著學生 進行各種教學活動,另外,每間教室都簡樸溫馨, 設備雖不是最頂尖,但學生各個都聚精會神的勤記 筆記;戶外課則在上課前已換好體育服或泳裝以整 齊的隊伍等候老師上課,學生們各個溫文有禮,主 動而大方的向來賓問候,讓我們留下美好的印象, 可見晴海以良好的制度培養了學生學習尊重自己也 尊重他人的自律精神。

## Life as a Foreign Teacher - Dongshan High School

I have worked as a foreign English teacher at Dongshan high school since September 2011 and can honestly say it has been a wonderful experience.

Dongshan is a very large school compared to the school where I worked in England; I teach more students in grade 7 than there were total pupils in the entire school in England!

#### Curriculum

When I arrived at the school last school year there was no set curriculum for me to follow and this has given me the freedom to develop my own teaching materials. I use the textbook as a guide to the vocabulary and sentence patterns that the students are learning, and use this to create activities where the students can apply their knowledge in a variety of situations.

#### **Environment**

I believe that the space where students learn is very important to their development, and this school year I have been very fortunate to be given my own classroom. Before the start of the semester I cleaned and painted the entire room to create a refreshing learning environment. I also brought lots of things back from England to use in my classroom; there are flags and pictures on all the walls and newspapers and books in the English library at the back of the room.

I have also tried to make the room into an English only area, you will notice that there is no Chinese in the room and I encourage my students to use English as much as possible to communicate with myself and each other.



The other main advantage to having this English room is that I can decorate it at different times of the year. Next week it is Halloween and so my room at the moment is decorated with ghosts, pumpkins, spider webs and other creepy items that amaze the students when they enter the room.

#### Halloween - Teaching culture and customs

This week I have been teaching my first year classes about the very popular Halloween festival. To really give the students a true experience I decorated my classroom with ghosts, pumpkins, spiders and other Halloween objects. I also bought two Halloween costumes to wear during the class. To set the scene I turned off all the lights in the classroom, put on my grim reaper costume, and played the haunting piece of music from the famous movie 'The Exorcist'. As my students tentatively entered my room I jumped out from behind the door wielding a scythe. I guess some students have never learned about Halloween before as they were genuinely shocked and scared!

Next, I showed my students some actual photographs of a Halloween party that I had in England a few years ago. I explained the tradition of wearing a costume and carving a pumpkin. The aim of my lesson was to teach the children ten Halloween costumes. First, we used flashcards to learn the vocabulary and discuss the costumes. Then to consolidate their understanding we played a fun game where the students battled boys against girls. The students had to say a short sentence using one of the new words. If they answered correctly then they had to open a door in a haunted house to reveal either a pumpkin (+1 point) or a ghost (-1 point). The students love competitions and this game engaged all

the pupils from across the wide ability range.

The students also really enjoyed playing a game in the following lesson where they had to be blind folded and then put their hand into a witch's cauldron containing a gooey slime. The aim of the game was to pick out the various body parts that we had previously learned in class. The hand, fingers and foot were very realistic looking and this gave the students a real scare!

Overall, the students thoroughly enjoyed the two lessons and not only learned English but also a little bit about the Halloween festival.
